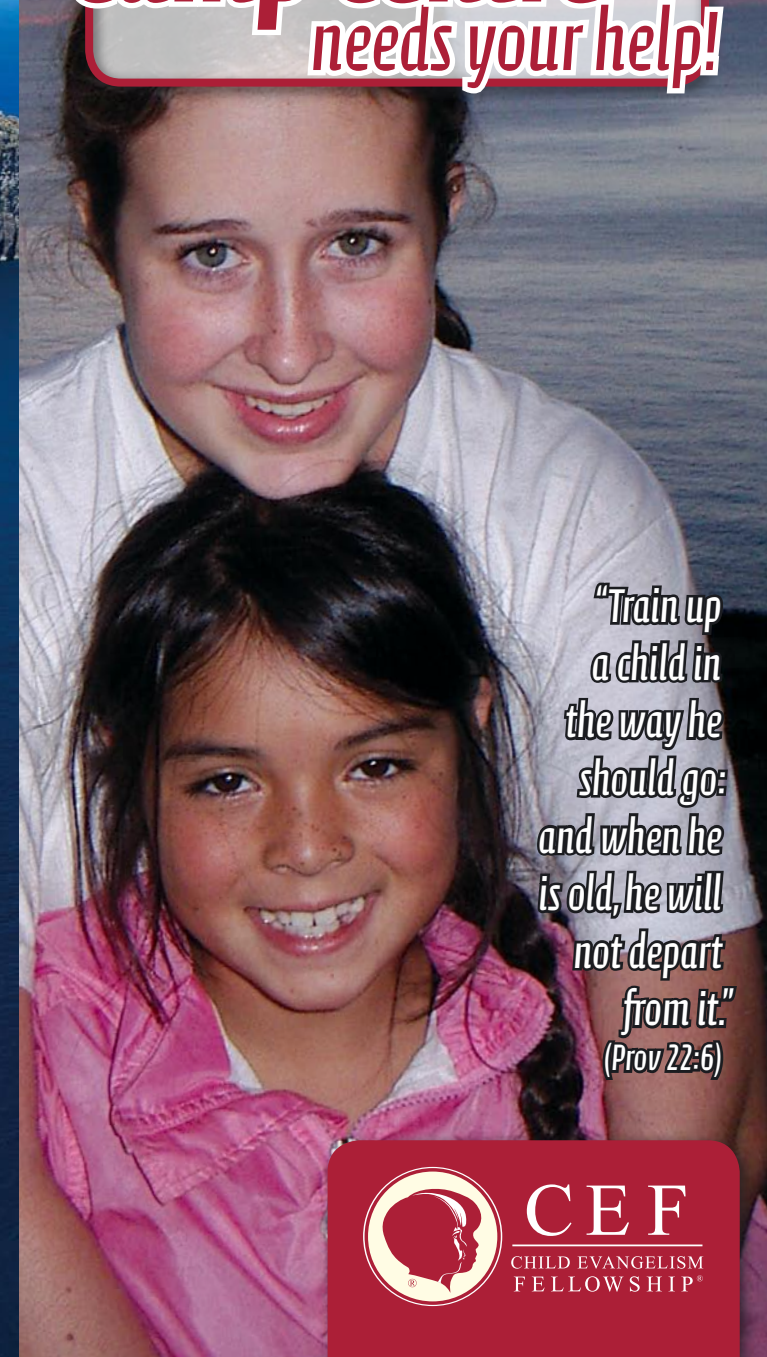

The Need

The Azores are a group of nine Portuguese islands in the Atlantic, mid-way between Portugal and N. America.



The population is 250,000, but the evangelical community is small – four of the nine islands have no Protestant church.

There are no other missionary organizations like *Child Evangelism Fellowship*® on any of the islands and no other Christian facility to hold camps. Up until now it has been necessary to use borrowed tents. Primitive kitchen and dining facilities, as well as toilets have had to be constructed and dismantled.



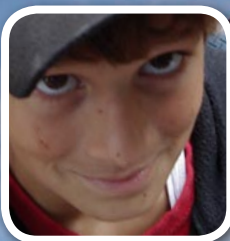
The Opportunity

An ideal property has been found for the camp centre which is well situated, a good size (4 acres) and at a great price.

The cost of the property including the present building, is €120,000. An additional €50,000 is needed, to make the place liveable, for landscaping, a shower block, kitchen/dining room and some basic equipment.

The local authorities are favourable to our having a camp centre.

Rev Art Nielsen, the pastor of the English-speaking church, has written: "This is a splendid property with space for everything we currently envision: director/caretaker's house, parking, trees for shade, a view of the sea, room for a pool, privacy, room for a substantial vegetable garden, fruit trees, sports field, picnic area, room for additional buildings, water, electricity and ... flat land."



The Goal

The camp centre will be used all year round for children's and young people's camps.

It will also be used for training courses, family retreats and church conferences.

The local *CEF*® workers, Clara Barcelos and Riale Fagundes, have developed a strong, effective ministry for the local Portuguese children, as well as for the children on the large US base of Lajes on Terceira Island.

Camps are a vital link in the *CEF* ministry. When children, scattered over several islands, come together, they not only receive good teaching, they also see the Gospel lived out before them in the lives of the counsellors.

The ministry of the camp centre will make a significant impact for the Lord in the Azores.
